NATURAL CALAMITIES

Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) the list of the total funds demanded by each State/UT, each year, during any form of natural calamity for the last five years and the funds released each year, State-wise/UT-wise, natural calamity-wise, year-wise details thereof;

(b) the list of number of deaths, number of injured, number of missing persons and the assessed loss of properties, in terms of Rupees, in each natural calamity of each State-wise/UT-wise, each year, in the last five years; and

(c) the list of visits by Central Ministers to the calamity affected areas of each State/UT during the last five years?

(a) & (b): As per the National Disaster Management Policy, the primary responsibility for disaster management rests with the State Governments concerned. The State Governments undertake relief measures in the wake of 12 notified natural calamities, from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) already placed at their disposal, in accordance with approved items and norms and magnitude of the ground situation. The Central Government supplements the efforts of the State Governments and provides requisite logistics and financial support. Additional financial assistance is provided

from the National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF), as per laid down procedure, in case of disaster of 'severe nature', which includes an assessment based on the visit of an Inter-Ministerial Central Team (IMCT).

Further, the allocation of SDRF to States is based on the recommendations of successive Finance Commissions, set up under Article 280 of the Constitution, from time-to-time. Further, the disbursement of assistance from SDRF and NDRF is governed by the Guidelines and Items and Norms of assistance, which are framed in consultation with all Stakeholders, including States and are available on Ministry of Home Affairs website [https:// ndmindia.mha.gov.in](https://ndmindia.mha.gov.in). The State-wise details of allocation and releases of fund from SDRF and NDRF during 2018-19 to 2022-23 are given in Annexure-I.

State/ UT-wise information on the number of people injured, missing and loss of properties in terms of Rupees, in each natural calamity-wise is not maintained by this Ministry centrally. However, State/ UT-wise details of losses alongwith number of deaths due to hydro-meteorological calamities during last five years i.e. 2018-19 to 2022-23, as reported by the State Governments/ Union Territories, are given in at Annexure-II.

(c): Information on the list of visits made by Central Ministers to the calamity affected areas of each States/ UT during last five years, is not maintained by this Ministry centrally.
